## **RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL AND OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION**

### **INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS:**

- Check your child's Hand Book everyday. Teacher's remarks should be noted and signed.
- Enquire about your child's progress at least once in a month.
- Use of foul language is forbidden inside the school campus. Any student, if found using such language, will be punished.
- Please inform your Child's teacher and the front office if your child needs to leave early. Parents are equally responsible for the safe passage of the child to and from the school. Parents' co-operation and involvement are mandatory for the discipline and academic progress of their wards'.
- Parents should seek permission at the office to meet a student or staff for a genuine reason.
- Parents are requested to maintain a separate file / diary for their wards' for academic follow up.
- Parents are requested to return any object the child brings from the school that does not belong to him / her.
- Parents / Guardians are requested to respond to the calls from the school positively.
- Parents should strictly avoid taking their children away from school during school hours for flimsy reasons. Parents should encourage their children to be present on the re-opening day of each term and participate in all school functions.

- Students suffering from contagious / infectious diseases will not be allowed to attend school. In such cases the student should avail the required recuperation time assessed by the doctor and specified on the medical certificate.
- Certificates and documents required by the parents for any purpose will be given to the parents after three days of written requisition.
- Parents are requested not to send their children with expensive ornaments, watches, or other electronic gadgets to school and the school will not be responsible for the loss of these items on the school premises.
- No student will be exempted from physical exercises and games without a medical certificate.
- Physical violence with classmate/juniors inside or outside the school campus will not be condoned.
- Parents must fill the absentees record and send a leave letter duly signed after a leave without fail.
- Any change of permanent / residential address should be immediately notified to the Public Relations Officer.
- No retest or re-exam will be conducted for absentees for any reason.

#### **EXPECTATIONS FROM STUDENTS:**

- Students are expected to behave responsibly in and out of School and to consider themselves as representatives of the school and its traditions at all times.
- School property should not be damaged.
- Students should display good manners at all times, and be courteous to each other as well as staff members and visitors to the school.
- Students are expected to be punctual and present for all classes unless they are ill. Late comers will be allowed to attend classes with Principal's permission only.

- The completion of all school work assigned is the responsibility of the student. This means, being organized, making good use of class time, completing all assigned home works, asking for help whenever necessary and completing missed assignments due to being absent.
- Adherence to the uniform code is required during the school days and when representing the school. Students are expected to wear the school uniform properly at all times. The Physical Education Trainer is competent authority to check the uniform.
- Students are expected to move safely within the school premises. We expect the students to walk and not to run when moving within the building.
- Students are strongly urged not to bring personal valuables like expensive watches, gold ornaments, Cameras and mobiles to school. Such items will not be returned if confiscated.
- Students should take care of their personal items. The school is NOT responsible for lost or stolen items.

**GRADING SYSTEM:**

- Evaluation is based on comprehensive grading system.
- Grades are given on the basis of grade descriptors. The students scoring Grade D and above will not be promoted to the next higher class.

**MARK OF EXCELLENCE:**

Students will be conferred awards depending upon their outstanding performance throughout the year.

**Misconduct**

- a) The following acts and conduct on the part of the students will amount to misconduct and the school will be constrained to take action deemed fit.
- i. Truancy either from assembly or class.
  - ii. Habitual late - coming.
  - iii. Indifference towards studies.
  - iv. Shortage of attendance without valid reason.
  - v. Rudeness or insubordination towards school authorities.
  - vi. Failure to participate in the co-scholastic/ extracurricular activities of the school.
  - vii. Stealing / pilferage of school/ student's property.
  - viii. Spitting or writing on the walls/ school furniture.
  - ix. Ragging/ bullying / Eve- teasing.
  - x. Malpractice indulged in during tests/ examinations.
  - xi. Misbehavior towards teachers or any other employee of the school.
  - xii. Damaging/ disfiguring school property.
  - xiii. Association with banned organizations.
  - xiv. Propagating communal/ caste feeling amongst the students.
  - xv. Indulging in physical violence in any manner.
  - xvi. Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher/ Principal.
  - xvii. Bringing unauthorized people/ articles inside the school.
- b) In above acts of misconduct, Principal shall take suitable action as per observation of the disciplinary committee depending on the gravity of the misconduct, which may include:
- i. Oral/ written warnings to the students and parents.
  - ii. Suspension from attending classes/ school for a specified period.
  - iii. Recovery of loss to school property.
  - iv. Issue of Transfer Certificate.
  - v. Expulsion/ rustication from school.

## **FEE**

1. Students once admitted are expected to continue for the entire academic year. If, however a parent feels the need to remove a student for personal reasons in the middle of the year, the entire fees will have to be paid.
2. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances or for any reason whatsoever.
